Dreamgirls at the Lower Ossington Theatre

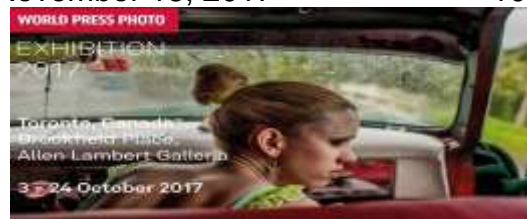
